Pole top wireless photo guideline

When submitting site photos with your step 1 form, the following requirements must be met.

- 1. All photos must be provided in digital format (JPEG).
- 2. Each photo file shall be titled in accordance with the following naming convention:
 - O Photo#-PoleID#-DirectionFacing, ex. P2-1234567-North.
- 3. Site photo packages shall be submitted in .ZIP format and not exceed a 10MB file size limit.
- 4. Wherever possible, each set of site photos shall include views from the following orientations:
 - O Behind the pole, looking ahead span.
 - In front of the pole, looking back span.
 - Front facing elevation of the pole.
 - Back facing elevation of the pole.
 - O Close-up photo of existing pole ID tag.
- 5. If geographical or access constraints prevent taking the standard set of site photos, all efforts shall be made to obtain a set of photos which at minimum provide a full 360° view of existing equipment on the pole.
- 6. Each site photo shall include a full view of the pole from ground to pole tip.
- All existing BC Hydro, TELUS or 3rd party equipment on the pole shall be clearly captured in at least one photo of the structure.
- 8. All existing telecom equipment below the secondary level of the pole shall be clearly identified, including the equipment owner.
- All photos shall be taken during daytime conditions and in adequate lighting and weather conditions to ensure detailed structure features can be identified.
- 10. All photos shall be clear and generally free of motion blurriness, lack of focus, lens obstruction, sun glare or discoloration.
- 11. The standard photo set orientations shall include local background landmarks for ease of site identification. Landmarks could include, but are not limited to: street signage, business signage, parks, natural landmarks, existing distribution or transmission electrical infrastructure or significant geographical and/or access features.
- 12. All photos shall be taken using a device which tags the photography with geo-referencing data and time stamping of the date and local time at which the photo was taken.
- 13. All photos must be dated within 30 days of the date of step 1 application submission to BC Hydro.

Tagging/labeling requirement

 The equipment box shall be clearly marked with the owner's equipment ID#, the company name, and the emergency contact phone number.
