By completing and forwarding this form, I declare that the service address¹ meets the BC Hydro Electric Tariff availability clause for Rate Schedule 1401 - Irrigation which states:

"For motor loads of 746 watts or more used for irrigation and outdoor sprinkling where electricity will be used principally during the Irrigation Season as defined below. Supply is 60 hertz, single or three phase at the secondary or primary potential available. BC Hydro reserves the right to determine the potential of the service connection."

The Electric Tariff defines the Irrigation Season as:

"In respect of each Service Connection the period commencing with a meter reading on or about March 1 in any year, having a mid-season meter reading on or about July 31, and ending with a meter reading on or about October 31 in that same year. BC Hydro may, in its discretion, extend such period by postponing the termination date to any date not later than November 30, for the sole purpose of permitting a Customer to fill reservoirs necessary for the operation of the irrigation or sprinkling system."
