

What you can expect on your bill

You've opted into our optional residential tiered rate with time-of-day pricing. On this plan, electricity is more expensive during the evening and cheapest overnight. On your bill you'll see on-peak charges with a surcharge of 5 cents per kWh, an overnight discount of 5 cents per kWh used, and an off-peak charge which doesn't have a discount or surcharge applied.

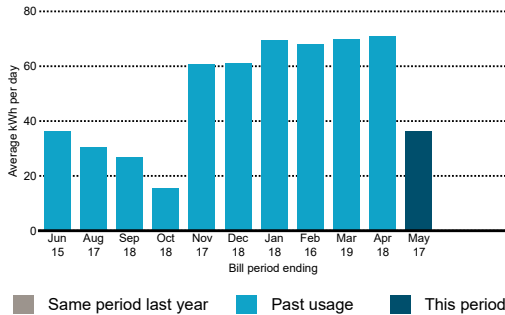

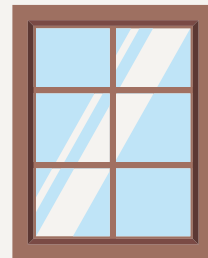

TIME-OF-DAY PRICING

By opting into our optional residential tiered rate with time-of-day pricing you'll see various charges on your bill. Here's what they mean:

- 1 We apply a surcharge of 5 cents per kWh to all electricity that was used during the on-peak period (4 p.m. to 9 p.m.)
- 2 No discount or surcharge is applied to electricity used during the other hours of the day (7 a.m. to 4 p.m. and 9 p.m. to 11 p.m.)
- 3 We apply a discount of 5 cents per kWh to all electricity that was used overnight (11 p.m. to 7 a.m.)

Step 1 Step 2
