WITNESSES that the Customer and BC Hydro agree as follows:

1. This Agreement covers electrical Service to the Premises located at _____.
2. The supply of Electricity will be alternating current _____ phase _____ wire, having a frequency of approximately 60 hertz metered at a nominal potential of _____ volts and delivered at a nominal potential of _____ volts at the Point of Delivery, subject to normal variations from the said frequency and voltages.

3. The Electricity supplied and taken is subject to the terms, conditions and rate schedules of BC Hydro's Electric Tariff as amended or replaced from time to time, which is approved by the British Columbia Utilities Commission and available on BC Hydro's website (the "Electric Tariff"). The Customer may also inspect the Electric Tariff of BC Hydro during normal business hours at BC Hydro's Head Office or its other general offices, and such right to inspect is sufficient notice of the terms and conditions and rate schedules contained therein. Capitalized terms but not defined herein have the meanings given to such terms in the Electric Tariff.
4. This Agreement will become effective on the date of commencement of Service for the Customer, and will continue in force until terminated in accordance with the terms hereof. This Agreement will terminate automatically without further notice by either party if Service to the Customer is Terminated in accordance with the terms of the Electric Tariff, or if the Customer ceases to be the Owner or to have the right to possession of the Premises. If the Customer breaches the Electric Tariff, BC Hydro may, at its option, immediately terminate this Agreement by providing notice of termination to the Customer. Either party may terminate this Agreement by giving the other not less than thirty (30) days written notice, and this Agreement will automatically terminate upon the expiration of such notice period. This Agreement is non-transferrable and may not be assigned by the Customer.
5. The Customer's expected Maximum Demand will be _____ kW ("Expected Maximum Demand"). BC Hydro will consent to any increase to the Customer's Maximum Demand up to the Customer's Expected Maximum Demand during an initial period of 5 years, beginning from the energization date of the Customer's Service. After 5 years, where the Customer intends to increase their Maximum Demand by an amount greater than the limit prescribed in the Electric Tariff, the Customer must apply to BC Hydro to request a new or modified service and an additional Extension and/or System Improvement as set out in the Electric Tariff may be required for BC Hydro to consent to the requested Maximum Demand increase. A new Agreement will be required for BC Hydro to consent to increase the Maximum Demand.

6. Notwithstanding the construction of an Extension by the Customer, or by a previous Customer at the Premises, BC Hydro will serve the Customer’s Maximum Demand. The construction of an Extension does not guarantee a future right to Service of the Expected Maximum Demand after the initial 5–year period beginning from the energization date of the Customer’s Service.
7. BC Hydro owns and is responsible for the maintenance of only the following electrical equipment installed or to be installed at the Premises.
- (a) Metering Equipment and metering transformers for billing purposes.
 - (b) BC Hydro transformers (see list attached).
 - (c) BC Hydro rental transformers (see Rental Agreement attached).
 - (d) _____span(s) of Primary Voltage Service Connection and/or _____span(s) of Secondary Voltage Service Connection.
8. BC Hydro is not responsible for the maintenance of any other electrical equipment located at the Premises, including such equipment identified as: _____.
9. The Customer will comply with the BC Hydro emission limit requirements. BC Hydro’s emission limit standards are available at bchydro.com/distributionstandards.
